The congregation offers a full calendar of liturgical services, as well as other special services like a Blessing of the Animals Service. Our worship services are 5:30pm Saturday and 9am Sunday.

Our committees and groups find many ways to serve the community and neighborhood. We collect food for the Lutheran Food Pantry, we stock the Emergency Food Pantry at Prescott School, and we serve monthly at the Gathering Place. Our women's group makes quilts, layettes, health kits and school kits for Lutheran World Relief and other charities. We also make our building available for community group meetings and educational events. Grace is a warm, caring community of faith that delights in serving others.

We offer educational opportunities for all ages, at various times during the week, and also provide social opportunities, such as Gourmet Group, an annual Pig Roast, and dinners before Lenten Vesper services. 

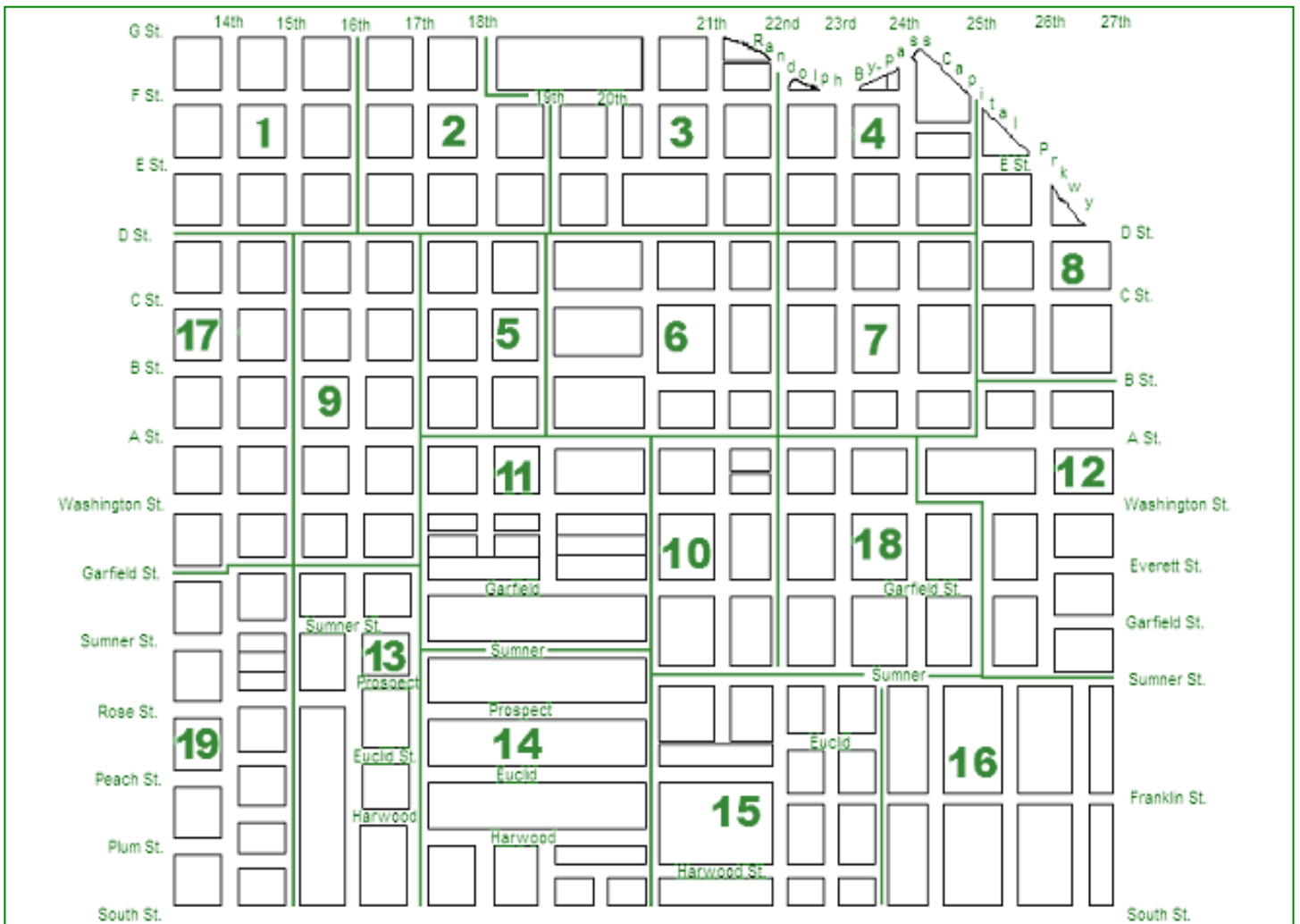


Walking Tour Books
