Previously, private residences have had volunteers do different projects such as raking, cleaning garages and basements, painting fences, and planting trees and flowers.

The Big Event will be held on April 21, 2012 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and will supply tools such as rakes, shovels, and paint brushes if needed. Private residences will be given 3-6 volunteers, depending on the jobs requested.

The Big Event is entirely student-run and funded by donations from the community. It is a great service project because it gives UNL students a chance to volunteer and say thank you for letting them be a part of this great community! Examples of projects we can and can't do include:

We Can:

- Paint exterior and interior of buildings
- Rake yards, trim bushes
- Plant trees or flowers
- Trash pick-up
- Pull weeds
- 1st story window cleaning
- Interior house clean-up
- Clean up gardens
- Organize files

We Can't:

- Use electrical equipment
- Scrape Paint
- Plumbing or electrical work
- Heating or air conditioning
- Handle asbestos
- Work with lead paint or exposed to toxic materials
